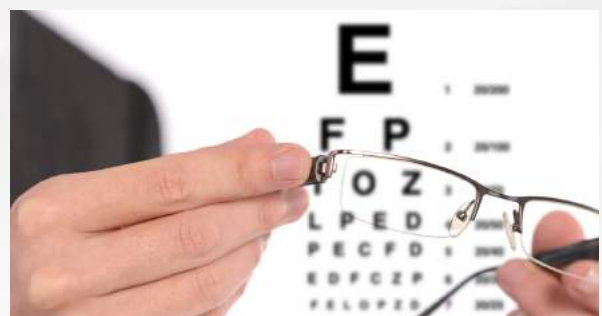
# ASIA PACIFIC COUNCIL OF OPTOMETRY

Out of them **53** were Ammetropic and **51** were ammetropic. Amongst **65** people had refractive error In which Refractive error observed: **2** patients with mixed Astigmatism, **14** patients with compound myopia, **9** patients with simple myopia **7** patients with Hypermetropia 29 patients with presbyopia (14 total presbyopia)

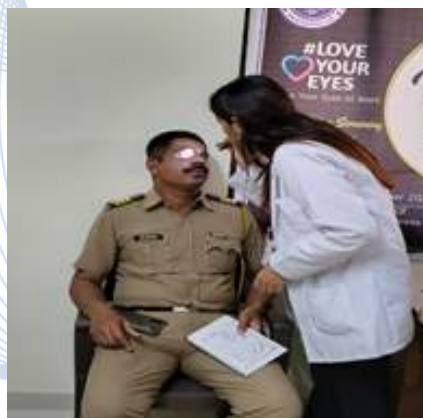


# DR. D.Y. PATIL INSTITUTE OF OPTOMETRY AND VISUAL SCIENCES

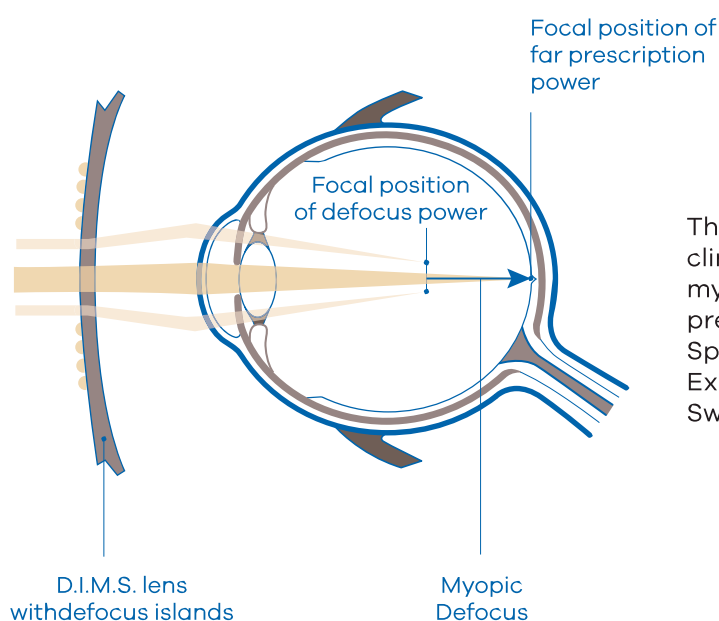

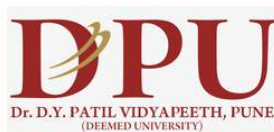
